## **8<sup>th</sup> Grade Party Guidelines**

To ensure the party is successful and safe, these guidelines have been set by Mrs. Nicklas, Ms. Smith, Katy ISD, and the 8th Grade Party Committee.

**Eligibility:** Only 8th grade students attending Cinco Ranch Junior High may come to the party. Singles and groups are encouraged. **SIBLINGS ARE NOT ALLOWED.** Contact Ms. Smith if you have more questions.

**Permission Slip and Party Fee:** To attend, the student and one of his/her parents or guardians **must** sign/submit the permission slip stating you have read, understand, and agree to follow the guidelines and pay the \$30.00 party fee. **All forms and money must be completed on-line or turned in no later than Monday, March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2018.**

**Invitations:** All students should have received an invitation during lunch. **THE PERMISSION SLIP WILL SERVE AS THE RSVP FOR THE PARTY. Without the signed/submitted permission slip and paid party fee, students will NOT be allowed to enter the party.**

**Party Information:** We have a fun night planned with a live DJ, photo booths, games, a variety of activities, and refreshments - all included in the price of the ticket. There will be a check-in booth for purses, shoes, and other small items. **The party will be from 7:00pm to 10:00pm.**

**Drop Off And Pick Up:** **LIMOUSINES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON SCHOOL GROUNDS AND ARE STRONGLY DISCOURAGED. DRESS CODE IS COCKTAIL ATTIRE. DRESS CODE COMPLIANCE WILL BE CHECKED IMMEDIATELY UPON ENTERING THE BUILDING.** Please start arriving to pick up your child at 9:50 p.m. **Please be on time to pick up your child.** Parents will not be allowed to enter the building.

**During party hours, the student may leave only in the company of his/her parent or another parent designated by a note written and signed by the parents in advance.**

## **8th Grade Party Dress Code**

If there are questions about the appropriateness of your cocktail party attire, please ask Ms. Smith, the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Assistant Principal, prior to the party. You may email Ms. Smith if you have additional questions.

- Be sure that all attire displays the upmost modesty and age appropriateness.
- Spaghetti straps WILL be allowed.
- Backless or strapless dresses or shirts WILL NOT be allowed.
- The front neckline of a dress must not come lower than the top of the armpits when arms are held straight out. See through mesh will not be considered appropriate, if removing the mesh would make the dress or shirt unacceptable to the party dress code.
- Dresses may not be shorter than mid-thigh. Slits may not be above mid-thigh.
- The midriff may not show. If the outfit is two pieces, the midriff may not show when arms are raised. Cutouts are not allowed.
- Pants must be worn at the waist and belted if appropriate. They may not be touching the ground, covering the foot, or excessively baggy. Pants must hemmed with no split or fringed edges. There may no holes in the pants. No shorts.
- Shirts or blouses may not be oversized or immodestly undersized. Shirts must be tucked in.
- Students who come dressed inappropriately will be asked to wear a t-shirt over their top or return home and come back within dress code guidelines.
- Suit coats and sport coats are acceptable for this occasion but are not required.
